Weekend slots will be reserved in two hour slots starting at 8 a.m. (8-10, 10-12, 12-2, 2-4, 4-6, 6-dark.)

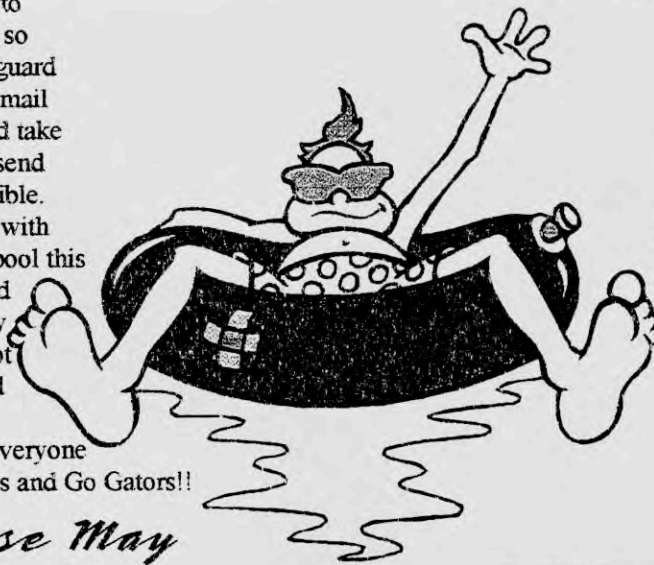

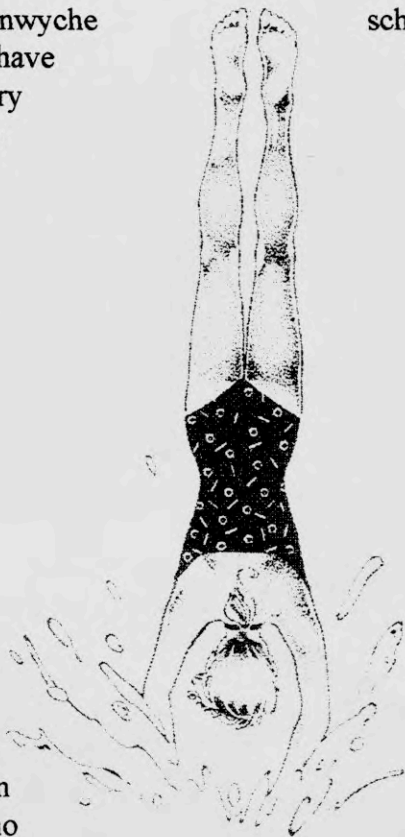
